Hamburg, Germany's largest port, is also a hub of innovative urban development. From sustainable housing projects like the Algenhaus to green infrastructure, climate-resilient neighborhoods, and smart mobility initiatives, the city is experimenting with new ways to make urban life more sustainable and inclusive. This seminar explores how Hamburg's history, global connections, and current challenges – especially climate change – shape its urban transformation.
